INTRODUCTION

RESIDENT EDUCATION PROGRAM 2006 – 2007

Although the acquisition of a comprehensive surgical capability cannot be achieved entirely through a series of meetings, the didactic component of our surgical educational program outlined herein is considered essential in the development of a complete or true general surgeon. We have assembled a comprehensive program which provides fundamental background knowledge of interest and importance to all residents for their continuing surgical experience. The material only aims to complement the other educational efforts which each resident must make on an individual basis. There is an attempt made to use currently available clinical material whenever possible in the educational program. To miss even one of the meetings in this curriculum will leave a void in the resident's bank of essential information.

To be effective, a program relies on the dynamic efforts of the participant. It is critical that those who present information and those who receive and digest it make certain that the essential data will be retained. "Learning" as well as "teaching" must occur. Repetition and mental concentration are required before information becomes practical working knowledge.

All residents are expected to regularly attend each session and to participate actively in all meetings; only emergency or urgent responsibility should preclude this commitment. It is the sincere objective of each staff surgeon in our department for every resident to attain excellence in surgical judgment and operative technical skill. In the 2006-2007 year, we have instituted "protected" educational conference time. Every Wednesday from 2 pm to 6 pm, residents are expected to be in the conferences scheduled. Trauma emergencies will be handled by the Trauma rounder, Trauma PA and the non-surgery resident rotating on trauma. General Surgery emergencies will be handled by the General Surgery attending or on call attending with non-surgery resident rotators. The Chief residents are expected to keep Wednesday afternoon free of elective cases. Only in absolute situations would any surgical residents be allowed to be called out of these conferences for clinical cases. The "**night-float**" resident is expected to participate in all of the Wednesday afternoon conferences including M & M Conference, Grand Rounds and educational lectures. Residents who are rotating at the integrated hospitals, including Memorial, San Joaquin, Bakersfield Heart hospitals are expected to participate in all educational activities. Residents rotating on Pediatric Surgery in Fresno are expected to return to KMC on Wednesday afternoon to participate in all educational activities on that day unless scheduled to be on-call in Fresno. This is agreed upon by all associate program directors at various sites and is a requirement of the RRC. Residents on the UCSD rotation and on Dr. Miro's Vascular rotation are the only two residents excused from these protected educational conferences.

The didactic portion of the Resident Training Program is outlined within this booklet for the academic year 2006-2007. The format for the next year's educational activities will be similar to prior years except for the following changes. In regard to the Wednesday protected conference time, the first hour will be Basic Science Conference (1st Wednesday), faculty lecture (2nd, 4th and 5th Wednesday, if available), Oral Board Examination Practice (3rd Wednesday). The second hour will always be SESAP review. The third hour will be M&M Conference and the fourth hour will be Grand Rounds.

We have continued with ACS SESAP 11 as a review and preparation for ABSITE. The multimedia format will allow approximately 15 questions to be discussed in detail each Wednesday. In addition to SESAP, the Basic Science Conference and the Faculty Lecture series will provide basic science and surgical theories for our residents. The Interesting Case Conference, Trauma Conference, Oncology Conference, Critical Care Conference, GI Conference and Orthopedic lecture series will be continued as before. These conferences will provide clinical knowledge and management skills for our surgery residents. The Summer Core lecture series will last until September, which will provide adequate survival skills and knowledge to the PGY1 residents.

The monthly Journal Club stimulates critical review of journal articles and interests in clinical research and will be continued every second Wednesday evening. Dr. Meade and Dr. Thomas have put together a 3-year cycle of topics. All faculty and residents are expected to participate. Dr. Chang and Dr. Lee will work with Dr. Meade and Dr. Murr in selecting articles. One review article related to the topic will be selected with several current journal articles. Residents will be assigned monthly to present the articles selected. In addition to learning new medical information, it is also important to develop the skill of critical review of journal articles. A suggested journal club outline is included in this booklet. The purpose of the Journal Club is to review critically current publications rather than to review a subject in depth. If you keep this in mind, the Journal Club will be more attractive and rewarding.

The weekly M & M Conference and Grand Rounds are the main departmental conferences. Residents are expected to be honest in reporting all complications and deaths. The department has a software program that will allow you to record the incident and be included in the weekly M&M package. Please complete your case on this program by Friday the week before the scheduled conference. Surgical Grand Rounds are presented by UCSD faculty and other well-known speakers of their fields. This is an excellent opportunity to learn new approaches to disease treatment. All faculty and residents are expected in these conferences.

The Summer Core lecture series organized by Graduate Medical Education provides important material for all interns in the summer months. During these months, the Tuesday noon conferences, Surgery Review-SESAP Conference, Surgery Oral Board Practice, Faculty Lecture series and Basic Science Conference will not be held until September. All other conferences will continue in the department.

In addition to the above conferences, the department also provides our resident with courses leading to certification in ATLS, ACLS and FCCS. Please check with Diane Duclos regarding signing up for these courses.

There is continuing need for documentation of the educational activities and the resident of each week's assignments is responsible for keeping an attendance record and submitting it to the Program Coordinator, Diane Duclos, on an ongoing basis. Please be sure to sign the attendance list in order to receive appropriate credit.

I am absolutely convinced that in order for our educational activities to be successful, it is necessary for the residents to commit attendance and participation throughout the year. But there is no substitute to continual self motivation and continuous reading of surgery textbooks throughout your training. All residents should review current journal articles in each disease the residents encounter. Taking advantage of the structured as well as the informal teaching program within our institution over a five-year period will complement your reading and prepare all residents for mature clinical practice and for successful passing of the examinations and board certification.

INSTRUCTIONS TO RESIDENTS AND FACULTY

1. Please go through the book carefully and define your assignments for the entire year.
2. Make contact with the attending staff and outline your responsibility and role during your presentation **at least one month in advance**.
3. During the week of your assignment, you are expected to:
 - a. Arrange to be available during the educational session.
 - b. Prepare clinical presentations and audiovisual material as needed (PowerPoint, LCD panel projector, radiographs, etc.)
 - c. Circulate Journal Club articles two weeks in advance, if applicable. Also, prepare copies of articles for the senior staff and residents.
 - d. Keep an attendance list and turn it in to Diane.
4. Sessions are held either in Room 1058 or 1065. Journal Club is usually held outside of the hospital sponsored by a pharmaceutical rep. Please coordinate this with Diane or Nora.
5. Assistance is available in the Surgery Office when needed (for Journal Club lists, reference lists, presentation outlines, other reproductions).
6. If you are unable to fulfill your assignment, it is your responsibility to find coverage early enough to allow adequate preparation, not the day before. So, plan ahead!!!

SUGGESTED REFERENCE LIST

Surgical residents frequently inquire about textbooks, journals, and other reference material to be used during their training years. A precise list of references cannot be made since it would be incomplete. I would like to stress, however, the importance of utilizing all of the clinical material for learning. To accomplish this, quick reference to basic textbooks, use of monographs, system-oriented and organ-oriented textbooks, and current journals are a tremendous help.

The following list is an example of some of the frequently used surgical books and references. In addition to the ones listed, the residents should utilize supplemental books and journals in order to gain perspective in surgical pathology, surgical physiology, and historical developments in the science and art of surgery over the past century and should read as widely as possible for their own development. The selected Readings from the University of Texas are probably the most comprehensive, current material of use to the residents as well as to the faculty staff. These are available at the Surgery Department Library as well as the hospital library. Individual attending may have specific subscriptions to journals not available in the library.

The resident assigned to each session is to contact the assigned staff at least one month prior to the conference in order to adequately prepare for the session. The conference is arranged in a three-year cycle. The topics will repeat after the cycle is completed. A good reference book for this conference is "The Physiologic Basis of Surgery" by J. Patrick O'Leary, current edition.

- Dr. Murr will be providing residents with a one-page article summary to be completed with each article prior to each Journal Club.
- When selecting articles, Dr. Murr and Dr. Meade suggested having one review article related to the topic and several current articles to be studied and critiqued.

LAPAROSCOPY 101 AND ADVANCED LAPAROSCOPY INSTRUCTIONS

It has become necessary for all surgery training programs to document didactic and hands-on training sessions to attain a certain level of competency prior to participating in actual laparoscopic surgery. Kern Medical Center, under the guidance of Dr. Taylor and Dr. Chung, has set up a laparoscopic laboratory in the Department of Surgery for residents to practice basic laparoscopic skills. The KMC surgery training program has also subscribed to “Laparoscopy 101”, online didactic sessions developed and sponsored by Ethicon. Each resident will be given a CD-ROM disk with an online ID and password to log on to the surgical education website. The course is divided into nine (9) modules. Residents may work at their own pace to complete these modules within the first year. The final score will be transmitted to the program director and become a permanent record of each of the residents. Remediation may be necessary if a resident is unable to complete the modules successfully. In addition to the didactic sessions, three skill labs are to be incorporated into the course. These skill labs will be scheduled accordingly and will be announced once scheduled. Please contact Dr. Chung for your CD-ROM and passwords.

Dr. Taylor has finalized the laparoscopy skills laboratory. All PGY-1 residents are to become proficient in the basic laparoscopy skills described by Dr. Rosser’s “Laparoscopic Skills Enhancement and Suturing Course” before they can be allowed to perform simple laparoscopic surgeries such as laparoscopic cholecystectomy and appendectomy. By the end of PGY-2 years, all residents must become proficient in laparoscopic suturing techniques on animate objects as well as other advanced skills before they are allowed to participate in advanced laparoscopic surgeries. Please contact Diane Duclos for your copy of Dr. Rosser’s skills course.

During the course of the academic year, numerous basic and advanced laparoscopy courses are available throughout the country. The Department of Surgery will provide the expenses to allow residents at PGY-2 and above to go to these courses. Check with Diane Duclos for course availabilities.

ED/SURGERY TRAUMA CONFERENCE CURRICULUM

The ED/Surgery Trauma Conference consists of two components, didactic lectures and case presentations. On the second Thursday of each month, ED and Surgery residents are assigned to present various trauma topics. PowerPoint presentation is recommended. The trauma topics are selected in order to complete a trauma curriculum for Surgery and ED residents in a three-year cycle. The following is a list of all the trauma topics to be repeated every three years. On the fourth Thursday of each month, the trauma residents currently on the trauma service will present interesting trauma cases (see further discussion below).

ED/SURGERY TRAUMA CONFERENCE

Kern Medical Center has been designated as the only Level II Trauma Center in Kern County serving a population of 800,000 Kern County residents and residents of southern Tulare County. In 2004, KMC admitted close to 2500 trauma admissions making KMC one of the busiest trauma centers in the state. The combined ED/Surgery Trauma Conference is to improve medical knowledge and patient care competencies to enhance the care of severely injured patients. The conference is scheduled at noon on every 2nd and 4th Thursday of the month.

The goals of this combined ED/Surgery Trauma Conference are to provide education in basic trauma knowledge and in the care of severely injured patients. This biweekly conference is arranged to provide didactic teaching as well as clinical case presentations. On the second Thursday of each month, ED and Surgery residents alternate a trauma curriculum and prepare a lecture/presentation based on the curriculum and assignments. The curriculum follows a three-year cycle of topics and will repeat itself at the end of the cycle.

Interesting trauma case presentation will be scheduled for the fourth Thursday of each month. The Trauma residents (ED and Surgery) on the Trauma Service will select at least two cases with appropriate radiographic films and visual aids to be presented. The ED, Orthopedics and Neurosurgery departments are welcome to present cases as well. Please coordinate this conference with Michele Cecil, our trauma coordinator, one week in advance of each conference. Lunch is usually served.

CRITICAL CARE CONFERENCE

The Critical Care Conference is scheduled on every 3rd Thursday at 12 Noon. Dr Spinello typically selects interesting clinical cases for presentation. At times, Dr. Spinello, Dr. Murr, Dr. Meade and Dr. Chung will invite prominent speakers in the fields of Medical and Surgical Critical Care to speak at this conference. A pharmaceutical company usually sponsors breakfast.

TUMOR BOARD/ONCOLOGY CONFERENCE

The Tumor Board/Oncology Conference is a hospital wide conference. Participants include Family Practice, Internal Medicine, Surgery and Ob/Gyn. It is scheduled for the 2nd Wednesday at 7:30 am. Each department is assigned to select interesting and ongoing patient cases for discussion. Contact Dr. McBride at least two weeks in advance to submit your cases to be presented. A pharmaceutical company usually sponsors breakfast.

ORAL BOARD PRACTICE AND MOCK ORAL BOARD EXAMINATION

On the third Wednesday of each month an Oral Board practice session has been scheduled. This is an attempt to familiarize each resident with the oral board examination and to better prepare for such an important and stressful part of your career. Residents are assigned a specific date of testing. If you are unable to participate as scheduled, please identify your replacement and notify Diane Duclos, our program coordinator, as soon as possible.

The format of the practice sessions will follow closely the format of the actual Oral Board Examination. Two faculty members are assigned and will alternate scenarios and question each assigned resident in a 30 minute period. At the end of the session, critiques are sought from the faculty and from the audience. A score based on the ABS 7 point system will be assigned.

In addition to the above practice session, an on-site mock oral board examination will be scheduled with faculty from the integrated programs in Bakersfield. Residents at or above PGY-2 level will be expected to participate. These examinations are organized to provide self-assessment of medical knowledge as well as a practice for the real Certifying Examination at the end of your training.

KMC also participates in the Northern California Regional Mock Oral Examination for chief residents. This is usually held after the ABSITE examination each year. This examination is organized by UCSF-East Bay Program and has been an excellent practice for your actual examination. Two faculty members from KMC will also participate as oral examiners. This exam will be held at various locations. The Department of Surgery will provide transportation and lodging.

AMERICAN BOARD OF SURGERY IN TRAINING EXAMINATION (ABSITE)

This examination is provided by the American Board of Surgery as a self-assessment tool and is usually scheduled at the end of January across the country. All surgical residents are expected to take this examination and their score will be standardized and compared with scores across the country. While we will not be using the score of this examination as one of the criteria to promote residents, residents who routinely score less than 35th percentile in this examination will have an 80% chance of failing the actual ABS Qualifying Examination. We strongly recommend that you study throughout the year in order to perform satisfactorily in this exam. We expect that all of our residents be able to perform better than 35th percentile in this annual examination. Remediation may be necessary for residents scoring less than 35th percentile.

Objectives:

1. To provide an implementation mechanism that will facilitate the reliable administration of antimicrobial agents to KMC's surgical patients in a variety of settings.
2. To provide guidelines for KMC pharmacy committee to formulate a policy and set up a mechanism for this implementation.
3. To ensure that these standards are followed in daily surgical practice

Options:

1. We have specified the procedures in which the administration of antimicrobial agents has been shown to be beneficial.
2. We have examined the evidence regarding the optimal timing and duration of antimicrobial agents
3. We have omitted the dosing requirements to avoid errors in ordering the drugs especially in pediatric patients and those with renal dysfunction

Outcomes:

1. The intended outcome is more uniform and reliable administration of antimicrobial agents in those circumstances where their value has been demonstrated or their use has been judged by the medical community to be desirable.
2. The result should be a reduction in rates of postoperative wound infection for the prophylactic agents.
3. A limitation on the quantities of antimicrobial agents used for treatment agents will be realized.
4. The cost of morbidity of the infectious sequelae and excessive use of antibiotics should be reduced.
